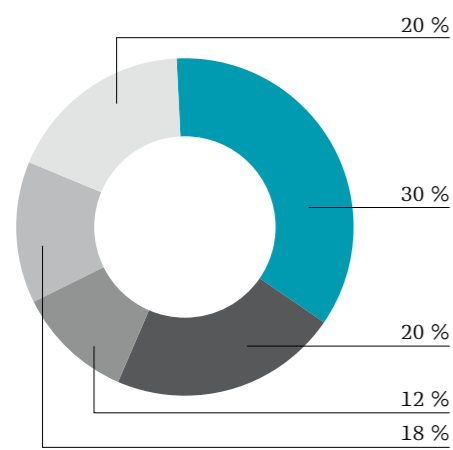
Yesterday would have been the 105th birthday of Sir Malcom Arnold, the versatile British composer who died last month, just as Decca was readying this tribute of three boxed sets respectively containing all his 11 great symphonies, 17 concertos and assorted works for orchestra, brass and piano. The core of this collection are 44 works recorded in the 1980s-90 with the composer's involvement.

Sport

Since 2002, Tiger Woods has played 89 official PGA Tour events (excluding match play) and 346 rounds and been paired with 173 players, most frequently Ernie Els, Vijay Singh and Robert Allenby (13 times). Woods beat playing partners by an average of 1.0 strokes or better in 69 of the tournaments (77.5%). Woods' score in major beat his playing partners' 67.2% of the time. Woods' average score was worse than his playing partners' in only five tournaments: the 2002 British Open (0.33); the 2003 Tour Championship (0.75); the 2004 U.S. Open (0.83); the 2005 Den Haag NL Open (1.33) and the 2006 Funai Classic (3.00); the 2007 Tour Championship (0.75).

Can Google Get Any Bigger?

Google's share price reached an all-time high Tuesday at \$518.84 with the announcement of a new partnership with marketing software maker Salesforce.com. Google, the #1 search engine, seems to defy every Internet law of gravity. But one question arises with each subsequent record-high share price: is it possible for Google to get any bigger?

According to Hitwise, for the four weeks ending June 2, 2007, Google accounted for 64.8% of all executed searches in the u.s., triple that of its nearest competitor Yahoo! Search, which achieved 21.7% of all searches in that same time period. Tech pundits (this author included) have long theorized that there must be a saturation point for Google's role in our quest to find information on the Internet. We just don't have a clue as to where that point may be. We've pondered the possibility of slips in dominance with the release of a new competitive offering, but that hasn't happened. We wondered if integration of MSN's search offering with the new Vista operating system would affect Google's share of search — not really. Google's role in our Internet use has become ubiquitous.

Google, in its transition from a noun to a verb, has become more than a tool to find information online, it's quickly becoming the default tool to navigate the web, replacing the browser URL bar as the way to move from one website to the next. How do we know this? The secret to Google's primary use can be found in the top searches that people enter on the site. The #1 term, representing over 4% of all u.s. searches on Google, is for the site that surpassed Google last summer to become the most popular domain on the Internet, MySpace. In fact 17 of the top 20 searches on Google are searches for the other leading Internet sites such as ebay, yahoo, and mapquest. The most puzzling search term that Internet users enter into a Google searchbox is the 14th most popular term: Google. (In case you're keeping count, the three most popular terms that are not websites are: porn, free porn and lyrics.) However, for all of its success, Google's online dominance has been limited to search. In web-based email, for example, Google's service, Gmail, is in a distant fifth place to leader Yahoo! Mail, which is over 12 times the size of Gmail in terms of visits. Google has barely made a peep in social networking; MySpace, the #1 social networking

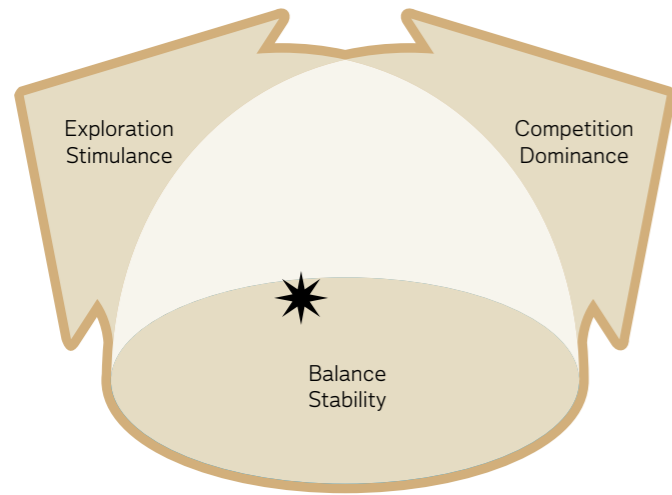

Based on the concept of Hans Georg Häusel this diagram shows the main emotional motivations the human brain can follow. Stimulance, Dominance and Balance. The position in the diagram shows the proportion of each motivation a typeface touches



Humble-Eccentric-Diagram
Here you can see how neutral or expressive a typeface is. From a craftsman to a Hollywood diva.



Classic-Neoclassical-Diagram
Between the 15th and the 18th century the proportions of type changed. In this range most typefaces find a position. proportions also play an important role in the ideal column width. More in the next chapter.



Book-Magazine-Diagram
Depending on the proportions a typeface workes better in a book, or a magazine.

Ideal column width

Every typeface has got it's own rhythm of how it hyphenates in a column and how much leading it requires. In typefaces with a small x-height (1, the same line space looks more open then in typefaces with a big x-height (2). Naturally the font with a big x-height looks bigger then the one with a small x-height.

When we reduce example 2 to appear the same optical size like example 1 (3, we can see, that the column width can be narrower and the line spacing can be tighter.

Example 1 with the small x-height follows classic proportions (4. The early roman typefaces from the Renaissance where structured like that. The ideal of geometry shown in the Capitalis Monumentalis influenced the capitals and the lower case.

The O, almost a geometric circle has a massive counter. The letter next to the O therefore needs to step away. Classic proportions only look good with much space inbetween and around. Books with wide and open columns are the best places to be for this typefaces.

Example 2 with the big x-height follows classic proportions (5. Younger typefaces from the 18th century like Walbaum stand at the end of a transitional period that not only influence the stroke. The width of the capitals is more similar here. The O is narrower then a circle. Neoclassical proportions seem to deal with space more effectively. Because columns can be narrower these typefaces work best in newspapers, magazines and as a corporate typeface.

So why not show some right column width with the right line spacing in the specimen (6.

In the examples only 8 pt, 9 pt and 10 pt copy is shown. By choosing i. e. 8.5 pt you can change the column width for your specific design.

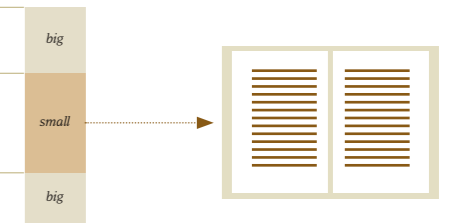

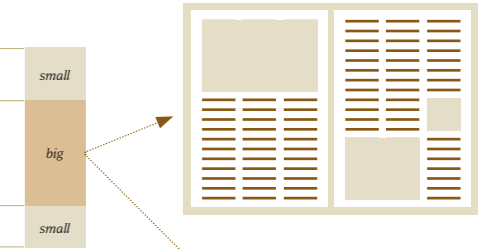
